

## Summer Staff Positions

### Day Camp—

**Assistant Coordinator:** June 6<sup>th</sup> —September 4<sup>th</sup>

Will assist the Day Camp Director in the day-to day activity involving campers, staff and parents. Responsible for assisting with the daily implementation of Bible program, thematic, skits, daily schedule and extra activities. Support Day Camp director with administrative, creative, and organizational gifts. Must have camp counseling and creative programming experience. Must be self starting, organized, fun-loving, and willing to go the extra mile to make camp meaningful and exciting. Essential to have a proven rapport with kids, a servants heart and contagious love for Christ. \$200 a week + housing and meals when kitchen is open.

**Worship Counselor:** June 6<sup>th</sup> —September 4<sup>th</sup>

First responsibility is to be a counselor to a group of Day Campers all day long. Secondary responsibility will be coordinating and implementing worship for Real F8th, Welcome and Closing activities. Will work closely with the Day Camp Director to plan and implement music and worship. Need contagious love for Jesus, and the ability to lead singing for large groups of children. Must have strong accompanying skills on guitar. Must demonstrate good communication skills and spiritual maturity. \$180 a week + housing and meals when kitchen is open.

**Crafts Counselor:** June 11<sup>th</sup> —September 4<sup>th</sup>

First responsibility is to be a counselor to a group of Day Campers all day long. Secondary responsibility will be to create an exciting, creative, enjoyable, and organized experience for campers in the Crafts area. Creativity and love of interaction with elementary age campers required. \$155 a week + housing and meals when kitchen is open.

**Recreation Counselor:** June 11<sup>th</sup> —September 4<sup>th</sup>

First responsibility is to be a counselor to a group of Day Campers all day long. Secondary responsibility will be to create and facilitate activities including field games, large group games, and help with theme parties. Also responsible for daily upkeep, inventory and cleanliness of recreation equipment for day camp. Hard working attitude, ability to plan and set up games and activities and capacity to lead large groups necessary. \$155 a week + housing and meals when kitchen is open.

**Program Counselors:** June 11<sup>th</sup> —September 4<sup>th</sup>

First responsibility will be to be a counselor to a group of Day Campers all day long. Secondary responsibility will be coordinating and implementing skits, puppet shows, and other on stage activities for Real F8th, Welcome and Closing activities. Will work closely with the Day Camp Director and worship counselor. These people must be creative and able to be on stage in front of a large group of children. Must demonstrate good communication skills and spiritual maturity. \$155 a week + housing and meals when kitchen is open.

### Adventure Programs:

**Adventure Staff:** June 11<sup>th</sup>—August September 4<sup>th</sup>

Responsibilities may include life guarding, facilitating high ropes, zip lines, giant swing, indoor climbing wall and low ropes. Previous ropes course experience and lifeguard certification is preferred. \$150 a week + housing and meals when kitchen is open.
